FOR THE RECORD:

I just had a chance to watch the video from last Thursday’s 10/24/24 public hearing. During attorney Heller’s questioning after my presentation, I realized that I misinterpreted one of Harry’s topics.

Here is how I’ve transcribed the relevant section, beginning at approximately time stamp 20:59:10:

Attorney Heller: “Over the course of this proceeding and the prior application that was withdrawn by Gales Ferry Intermodal, at any time did you have any discussions concerning the application with either present or past members of the Planning & Zoning Commission, outside of the public hearing record?”

Dave Harned: “While the public hearing was active, are you asking?”

Attorney Heller: “While the applications were active.”

Dave Harned: “I don’t think so, I don’t recall.”

I thought that attorney Heller was asking if I had any discussions with the Planning & Zoning **Department**, which is why I responded, “I don’t think so, I don’t recall.”

To his actual question, my answer is unequivocally “No.” I had no discussions concerning the application with any present or past member of the Planning & Zoning **Commission**, outside of the public hearing record, while the GFI “Excavation” applications were active.
