Mr. Coen:


This letter is in response to your request to connect the property located at 59 Kings Highway, Gales Ferry, CT to the water main located along Kings Highway which is owned and operated by the Southeastern Connecticut Water Authority (SCWA). This public water system is part of the SCWA Tower Division.

After reviewing your request SCWA has determined that there is an adequate water supply in the Tower Division water treatment and distribution system. Therefore, your request to connect to this SCWA system is approved.

All construction and costs associated with the connection of the mobile home subdivision will be the responsibility of the developer and/or contractor. In addition, a system development fee and service connection fees will need to be paid to SCWA in advance of connecting to the SCWA water system. Connection to the water main on Kings Highway must be coordinated with SCWA prior to the main being tapped. All individual homes must have a separate water meter, installed by SCWA staff, prior to water being turned on at each unit.
