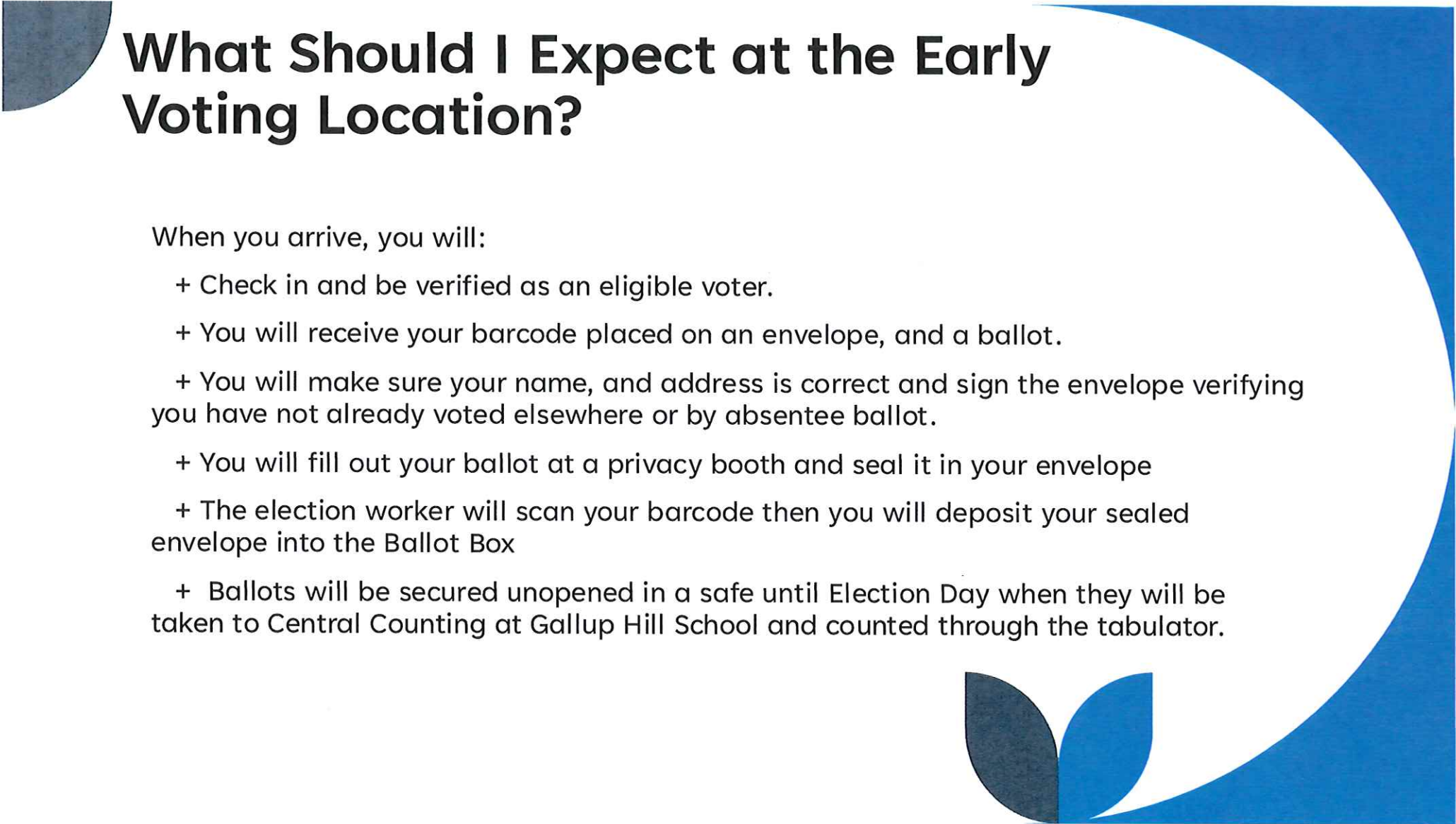
Your Say, Your Day, In Person

What is Early Voting?

Early Voting allows you to vote in person safely and securely before Election Day

Early Voting Location- Early Voting takes place at Town Hall lower level in Registrar's Office





What Should I Expect at the Early Voting Location?

When you arrive, you will:

- + Check in and be verified as an eligible voter.
- + You will receive your barcode placed on an envelope, and a ballot.
- + You will make sure your name, and address is correct and sign the envelope verifying you have not already voted elsewhere or by absentee ballot.
- + You will fill out your ballot at a privacy booth and seal it in your envelope
- + The election worker will scan your barcode then you will deposit your sealed envelope into the Ballot Box
- + Ballots will be secured unopened in a safe until Election Day when they will be taken to Central Counting at Gallup Hill School and counted through the tabulator.



How Does Early Voting Differ From Voting by Absentee Ballot?

Absentee Ballot Voting currently requires a reason (from a list of 6, found at MyVote.CT.gov).

Early Voting is available to every eligible voter without a specific reason.

Early Voting may be done only in-person, not via mail or drop box.

Early Voting includes weekends for most elections (see calendar for specific dates)

Election officials record that you cast your vote, preventing you from voting elsewhere, by absentee or on Election Day

Same Day Registration is available during Early Voting so you can register and vote on the same day.



SCHEDULE OF ELECTIONS

1) Every year Ledyard has a Budget Referendum in the Spring. The town charter calls for the Annual Town Meeting to be held the 3rd Monday in May with the adjourned vote the following day. All registered voters may vote, and non-registered voters may vote by property.

2) Every year the 1st Tuesday in November we have an Election Day.

Federal and State elections are on the even years. Municipal elections are in the odd years.

3. As needed, there is a Primary in September. This occurs if there is more than one person from the same party wishing to run for an office. In our State, primaries are closed and only members of that party may vote in a Primary.

4. Sometimes we have Special Elections if Town Council has a special project that needs to be voted on.

Where to Vote

All Budget Referendums, Early Voting and most Primaries take place at the Town Hall Lower Level, Registrars Office.

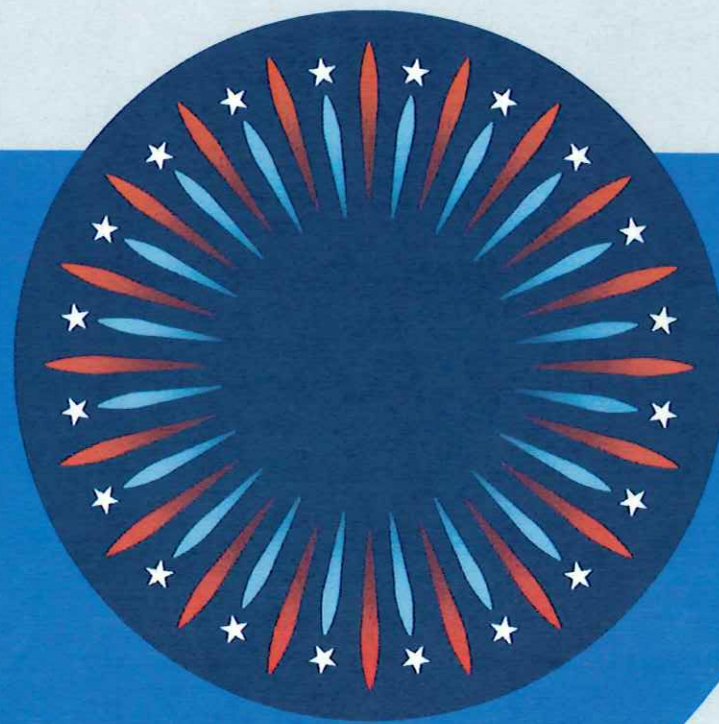
All General Elections in November take place at Polling Places by District:

District 1 votes at Gallup Hill School

169 Gallup Hill Rd Ledyard

Districts 2 & 3 vote at Juliet Long School

1858 Rt 12 Gales Ferry

Options Available:

- Online with your valid Driver's License number
- In person at our office
- Mail in with last 4 of your Social Security number
- Same Day Registration during Early Voting or on Election Day in our office
