Dear Commissioners and Ms. Burdick,

We are respectfully writing to you to voice our strong opposition to the quarrying of Mount Decatur as proposed by Cashman/GFI. Our concerns are many but here are some that we feel are most important.

1. Unreasonable pollution of the air, i.e. cancer-causing silica dust as well as pollution of the Thames River. See special permit criteria 11.3.4.F.
2. The excessive noise generated by the blasting operations lasting 6 days a week. See special permit criteria 11.3.4.C.
3. The traffic and noise generated by the quarrying operations additional truck traffic. See special permit criteria 11.3.4.B.
4. The loss of existing historical assets as well as neighborhood character. See special permit criteria 11.3.4.E.
5. The loss of property values in the surrounding neighborhoods. See special permit criteria 11.3.4.D.
