CRPA Members,

Thank you all for submitting testimony and making calls on HB 6952 & SB 6. Both bills were voted out of committee last week but several legislators did make comments that they had reservations about both bills.

SB 6 – the bill that would remove our exemption from licensure had new language but it didn't change the sections of the bill that impact municipal camps. As currently written (with the new language), it would still remove our exemption.

HB 6952 – which is the bill that is specific to municipal programs and camps does have new language (JFS). Please see 2nd attachment for a copy. We still have serious concerns with the new language. Please see attached legislative alert which outlines our concerns.
