Motion·to·clarify·the·action·taken·by·the·Town·Council·at·their·2/28/24·meeting·with·respect·to·Agenda-Item·11,·to·reinforce·that·the·reason·for·moving·the·Board·of·Education's·capital·lines·outside·of·the-Government's·Town's·Capital·Nonrecurring·Fund·was·to·make·the·process·of·using·appropriated·fundsmore·efficient,·and·create·a·smoother·workflow·for·both·the·Town·and·the·Board·of·Education.·¶

Further, it is noted that this motion, nor any action taken by Town Council or it's committees, cannot, under any circumstances circumvent the Town Charter, which states that the Town Council shall be deemed to be the budget making authority and the legislative body of the Town, and as such, is empowered to adopt a town wide budget inclusive of expected revenues and expenses for all departments and line items -- for presentation at the annual town meeting and approval at the annual town referendum. Additionally, the Town Charter requires that no department of the town shall spend money for any purpose in excess of the amount appropriated for each line item -- including CNR accounts -- until the matter has been approved by the Town Council. Accordingly, if additional revenue is received by the town within the fiscal year that is beyond the amount expected within the adopted budget, it must be appropriated for expenditure by Town Council.
