The proposed apartment complex at 19, 29 & 39 Military Highway Gales Ferry/Ledyard, Connecticut will adversely impact the protected wetlands contained within and adjacent to the listed properties. I do not concur with approval of the complex.

The five building "Multi-Family Residential" development poses a significant threat to the delicate ecosystem and wildlife that inhabit the wetlands and surrounding areas. Wetlands are vital for maintaining biodiversity, acting as natural habitats for various plant and animal species, many of which are already vulnerable.

The encroachment of this substantial residential project not only jeopardizes the local wildlife but also disrupts the vital functions these wetlands perform, such as water filtration, flood control, and carbon sequestration. The preservation of these natural areas is essential for sustaining local wildlife and protecting the ecological integrity of our environment.


