Director's Report to the Library Commission

Discussing March 2026 | Presented April 2026

Budget:

- Jessa presented the budget to the council on March 12 and it went well. The council asked a lot of questions, specifically about LION, ebooks, personnel/pages, and the operating line. Jessa did a fantastic job of answering all of their questions. What was supposed to be a 15-minute conversation turned into 40 minutes. We're very lucky to have Jessa at the helm, and we're hopeful that the council will not change what the mayor put forth in his budget.

Director Information:

- Jessa is home on maternity leave and doing well. She and Dominic are happy and healthy, and she's been logging in occasionally to catch up on and respond to emails as needed. Stacey, Lyndsey, and Matt are handling everything in the meantime, and we're happy to say that things are going very smoothly with library staff and patrons.

Library News:

- March was a very busy month for the library and it was a rousing success! The Friends held a pie sale and the pies sold out in under an hour! FOLL raised over \$900 between the pies and the raffle. Kudos to Jackie Bacon for all of her dedication and hard work, and FOLL is excited to do it again next year.
- The Seed Library opened on March 18 and it's been going well so far. We have already given out over 600 seed packets between the two libraries! This was also the day Lyndsey had her Etiquette & Elegance program with the Barnes Museum. There was a turnout of 20 people, and all attendees said that they really enjoyed it. She's hoping to have them back again sometime in the future.
- Fly Tying is a weekly series organized by Matt started on March 11. It continues to be an ongoing success. There are between 10 – 13 people who attend that each week.
- Stacey had two big programs on back-to-back Saturdays that were a huge hit! First was the whale program that was made possible with help from a grant from the Janet Barnett Legacy Project. There were around 100 people who were able to see the whale, interact with the educators from the Mystic Seaport, and visit all of the other stations we had for the event. It took a lot of work from library staff to make this event successful, and we're really pleased with how it went. The other event was an Inside Petting Zoo with lots of bunnies, a goat, and a tortoise. There were 131 people who attended and once again staff help was invaluable in making the event go well. These programs along with our very popular storytimes and other events means that youth programming is going like gangbusters!
- We are once again participating in the Passport to CT Libraries program. Passport to CT Libraries is a month-long program that encourages patrons to visit as many participating public libraries as possible. This year, there are 171 participating libraries! Patrons who visit the library will have a "passport" that each library will stamp (or sticker! We're stamping). Patrons are eligible to

enter a raffle to win a prize as long as they get stamps from 5 libraries. The patrons who visit the most libraries are also entered under their own category.

- Erica, our amazing head of tech services, is doing a fantastic job getting books cataloged quickly while also handling administrative tasks like putting together our monthly newsletter. One weekend the Laura and Beth got 75 items ready for the shelves! We were scrambling to find room and shift collections. Erica also cataloged the new switch games and the youth classics collections that are now available at each library.
- And I just have to highlight the audiobook statistics. I know we've told you that the Yoto players and cards were recently added and they have been a huge hit. They are cataloged as audiobooks. Our Youth audiobook stats are as follows:
 - December 2025: 8 Circulations
 - January 2026: 6 Circulations
 - February 2026 (including Yoto Beta-testing): 20 Circulations
 - March 2026: 229 Circulations! This is a **1045% increase** over February, and a **3717% increase** from January before Yoto beta-testing!
- Overall, March has been our busiest months in a while! A huge thank you to our staff for all of their hard work and dedication!

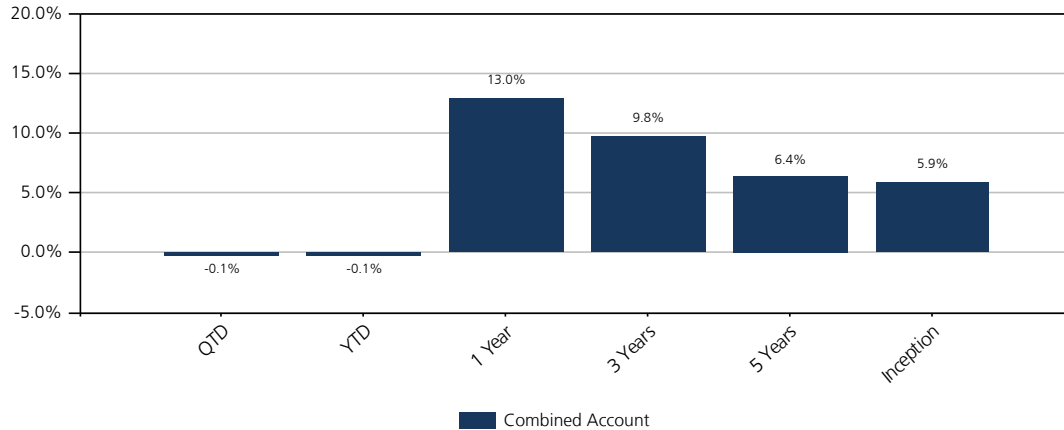
COMBINED PERFORMANCE AS OF MARCH 31, 2026

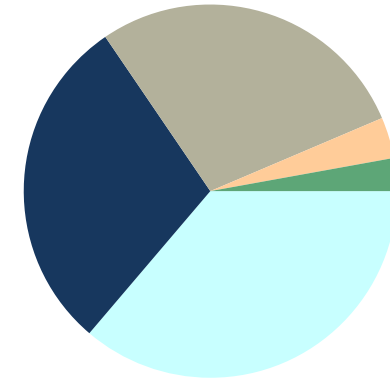

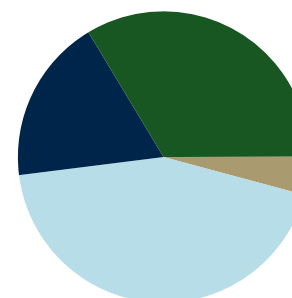

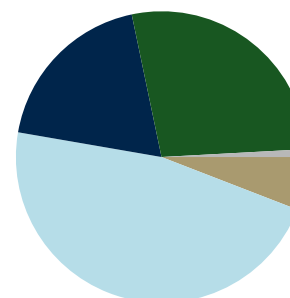

Net Invested Capital

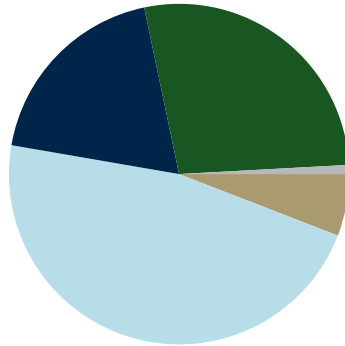

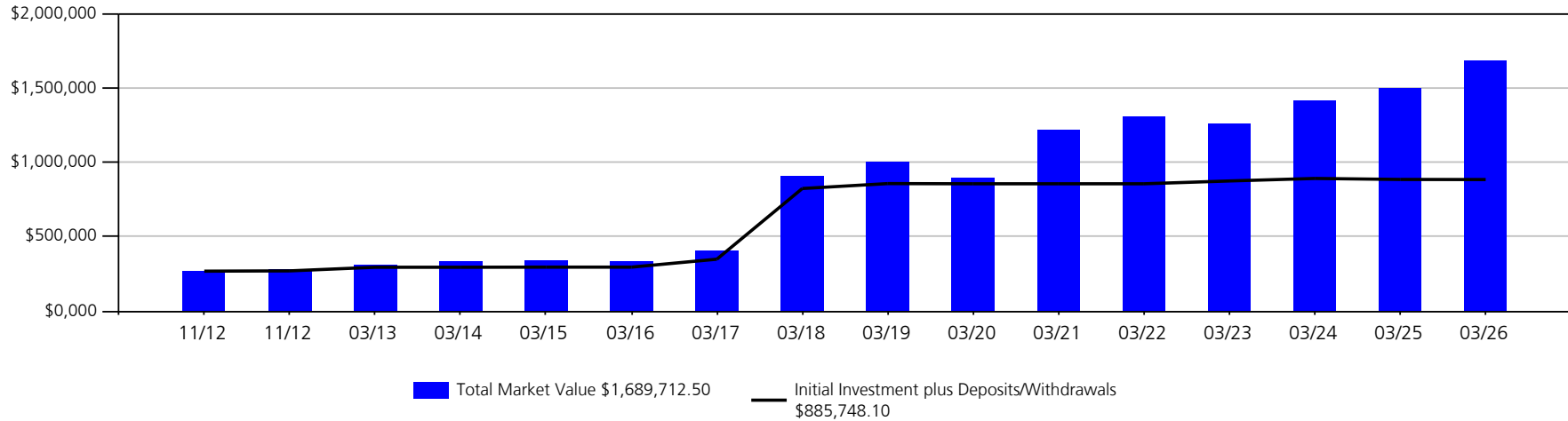

Net Invested Capital



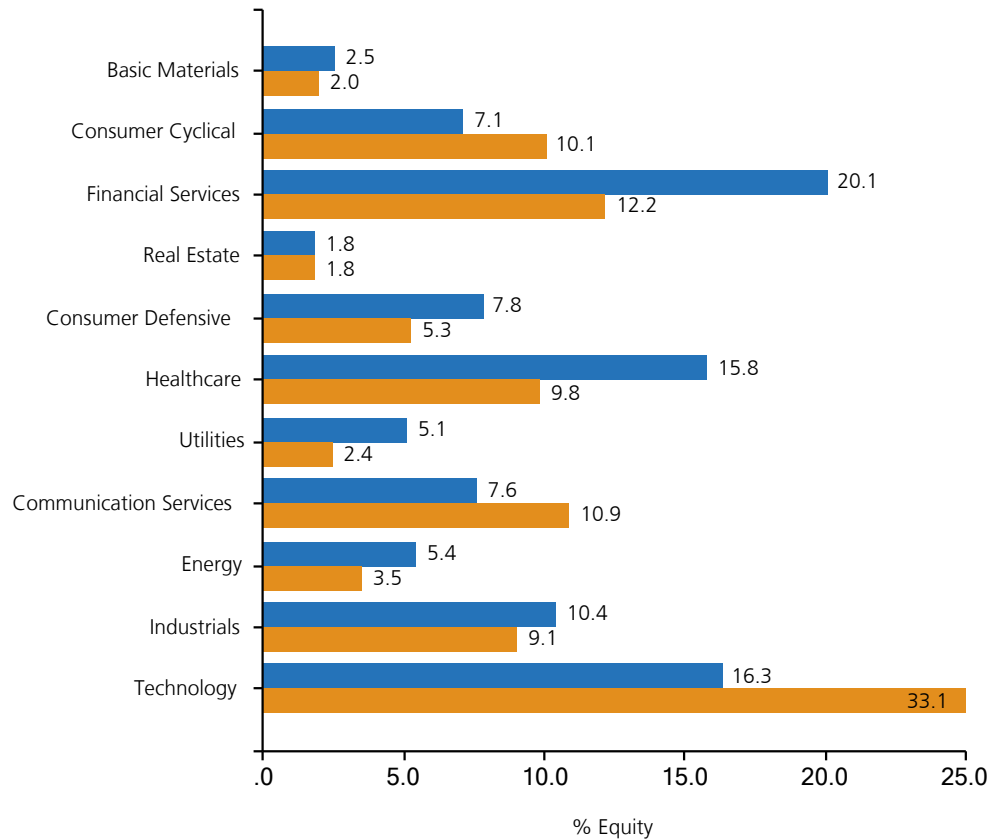
Cumulative Portfolio Results

IV. MEMBER COMMENTS

State Senator Osten is moving forward with a proposed bill, with the Mayor's approval, for library improvements at both branches. There is no known time frame at this time.

V. REPORTS

1. Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer's Report was reviewed.

2. Director's Report

Budget: • The Mayor's proposed budget included a cut that was anticipated; when submitting our budget, the number requested was somehow increased, almost doubled. Fortunately, we caught the error in our budget work session. His cut brought it back in line with our actual request. The work session went well, and the budget will be moving to the Town Council.

Maternity Leave Plans: • I have established procedures and responsibilities for our Leadership Team while I am on maternity. The commission has been informed of my plans, as well as the Town, library staff, and Friends of Ledyard Library.

Library News: • In February we took a look at our collections and have made some improvements. We are expanding our high-interest nonfiction titles for children, updating copies of classics for all ages, and expanding graphic novels for adults. We are also expanding our Nintendo Switch collection. In addition, we have reestablished our standing order for large print, utilizing Thorndike, which offers a much better discount than Ingram (25% vs. 8%). Keep an eye out for new titles at both buildings!

- Speaking of exciting collection news, our Yotos will be available for checkout on March 9th! Stacey did an amazing job working with a team of beta testers in February, and then developing both video and print instructions for staff on how to circulate them. This was incredibly helpful for everyone and I commend her for making the information available in multiple formats!

- I have continued my work on policies/practices and will have materials to share with you upon my return from maternity leave. Until then, staff will be proceeding as they have been.

- We are in the process of revitalizing our homebound delivery services. Lyndsey and I, with guidance from Christine in HR, are developing a new application for delivery volunteers, as well as an updated form for community members who want to use the service. Our goal is to create a form that covers the library and volunteer in terms of liability, while also making the participant's form easier to complete. We plan to have this in place before April so that the Friends of Ledyard Library can help us market the service.

- Our Marketing team has expanded to include a Paper Marketing Subgroup (Cathy,

Jackie, and myself) and a Newsletter Subgroup (Erica and myself). Staff have been informed of any procedural changes and we look forward to continued success for both areas. There is one additional subgroup left to develop, which may not happen until my return. Once established, the subgroups will meet periodically to maintain brand consistency across all platforms.

- Weeding projects are still going strong. Our goal is to have the nonfiction collection at Bill finished by the time I am back and then coordinate the change in shelving before the end of the fiscal year.
- Seed Library work is underway with a tentative opening during the week of March 16. Our community has been asking and we are excited to bring back this very popular program!
- We established a Processing Team made up of staff who have consistent hours at Bill Library and can support the processing and covering of new books. The team has been trained on the current practices and standards, as well as how to prioritize this work with their other duties. Erica did a great job hosting the training and creating a processing binder that the team can refer to at any time.
- We have a new passive activity we are offering at Gales Ferry: Pokémon Binders! Kids can visit the library to trade cards with the binder. There are rules to follow to keep it fair, i.e., no one can trade their valueless energy cards for a holographic rare Charizard. Fortunately, Pokémon trades will be facilitated by staff, primarily Stacey and Raven. This is a great compliment to our Pokémon Club that will hopefully bring kids in outside of the program.
