Dear Mayor Allyn:

At its Regular Meeting held on May 13, 2026 the Town Council took the following actions:

- Approved three tax refunds in the combined total amount of \$24,255.39. Each refund exceeding \$2,400.00 individually. Council action is required in accordance with tax collector departmental procedures.

✓ Devon & Angela Hunter	\$3,596.83
✓ Scient Federal Credit Union for Ryan & Kerrie Landry	\$7,686.86
✓ Hajjar Management Co. Inc. for Gales Ferry Realty Trust	\$12,971.70

- Transferred tax accounts in the amount of \$112,659.56 listed in the report dated April 8, 2028, to the "Suspense File".

In addition, authorized the transfer of non-refundable over payments in the amount of \$265.89 to the general fund listed in the report dated April 8, 2026.

In addition to the actions above, the Town Council discussed the additional supplemental State Revenues Ledyard was scheduled to receive for the upcoming 2026/2027 Fiscal Year as follows:

- Supplemental Education Aid: \$481,304
- Supplemental Pequot-Mohegan \$1,703,834.
- Total: \$2,185,138

It was reported that at their May 6, 2026 meeting the Finance Committee discussed a plan for how these additional supplemental state revenues would be used to stabilize the Fiscal Year 2026/2027 projected Mill Rate; which included minimizing the use of the Mill Rate Stabilization Fund with a goal to bring the Fiscal Year 2026/2027 to the adjusted/equalized Mill Rate. This new revenue information would be presented at the May 18, 2026 Annual Town Meeting.
