There is an issue with how the existing roof on the dormer comes into the lower roof. (bottom right and left of the triangle.) As with all of the trim this trim is copper. We are reluctant to remove it and replace it with a bronze color metal so the thought is to cut back about 18-20" of the rake that will allow the lower roofing metal to get under the rake and be properly water sealed. They would then fill in between the existing copper with either new copper or bronze colored metal trim. Board can decide once the pricing comes in.
