    - Access to Lower Level Town Green Construction of Muti-Use Pathway and Sewer Line Extension Construction Projects Ms. Ball noted that she has been communicating with the Mayor to ensure Vendors and visitors would be able to easily access the Lower Town Green. She stated that they would plan to use the Fairground Driveway for the entrance and exit for the season, unless they find that they were overlapping with the path construction.
