Subject:

Review the outstanding action items contained in the memo dated November 4, 2023, as forwarded by Land Use/Planning/Public Works Committee of the Twenty-sixth Town Council.

Background:

To provide for a seamless transition and for continuity the Town Council and its Subcommittees have traditionally identified and forwarded to the incoming Committee business items they believed warranted additional attention/action (please see attached memo dated 11/4/2023.)

- (1) Process to designate the Spicer Ruins, within the Clark Farm property, as a Registered Historical Site.
- (2) Progress of enforcing regulations to address blight issues.
