I am a resident of Gales Ferry Village at 2 Maple Corners Road, 1 block away from the proposed apartment buildings. The Gales Ferry Village is restricted on 3 sides by the Thames River,

Route 12 and the Cashman Industrial site; the only 2 entries are Military Highway and Hurlbutt Road which intersect at this proposed site. My concern is the the inevitable overflow of parking on our narrow streets where 2 cars cannot pass when there is on street parking. I do not believe we can absorb this overflow of parking from these proposed apartments. without significant harm to the character of this area. It would double the number of cars circulating on Military Highway and Hurlbutt Road.

Another factor is that the height of a 5 story apartment building would once again significantly impact lighting, noise, and street usage of a rural, suburban community.

I speak in opposition to the the proposed scale of this apartment building complex Which would greatly affect this community.
