- I will attend the next Finance Committee meeting to hopefully have the Finance Business Request approved for the fiber at Gales Ferry. If that is approved, the next phase can begin making us that much closer to having the fiber lit.

Building News:

- Our Bill Library alarm was accidentally activated twice last week and a service call was needed to amend the security system. Starting in July 2023, the Public Works Department will be taking over the responsibility of all alarm and fire panel responsibilities at both library buildings.

Town News:

- The Mayor signed off on the ALA Libraries Transforming Communities grant. Thank you to Rolf for providing a great letter of support! The award notification date is April 19.
- The Ledyard Rotary invited me to be a guest speaker at their meeting on February 23.
