We had 21 people come for the terrarium project but we also partnered with the Ledyard Beautification Committee to hold their Earth Day event at the same time. They had a drop off your trash, recycled sculpture contest, and plant swap that went well. We always enjoy partnering with others in the community and hope to do it again next year.
- It looks like we will be getting new windows in the children's room at Gales Ferry library sometime in late May or early June. This means we will have to close access to the children's room at Gales Ferry from a Thursday to Monday. This shouldn't be too much of a problem because this is the time of year the Youth Department takes a break from programming to prepare for summer activities.
- Our Tech Services department is doing well keeping up with the demand of processing the books that are coming in in droves. This is due to the need to order things before the end of the fiscal year.
