At its Special Meeting held on August 6, 2025 the Town Council took the following action:

- Elected Councilor Gary St. Vil to serve as the Town Council Chairman to fill a vacancy left by former Chairman S. Naomi Rodriguez.
- Appointed Ms. Adrienne L. Parad (D) 5 Birch Street, Ledyard to the Town Council to fill a vacancy left by Chairman S. Naomi Rodriguez, in accordance with Chapter II Section 10 of the Town Charter.
- Appropriated \$10,000 to Account #21020301-57300-G0015 (Fire Marshall - New Equipment - State Grant).

In addition, authorized the expenditure of up to \$10,000 to complete the upgrade to the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) for Emergency Management.


The funding source for this project is the Town of Ledyard's FY 2026 Nuclear Safety Emergency Program Funding.

- Approved a proposed Assistant to the Director of Land Use & Planning Job Description as presented in the draft dated June 10, 2025.
- Approved a proposed Office Assistant II – Mayor's Office Job Description as presented in the draft dated June 24, 2025.
- Approved proposed updates to the Executive Assistant to the Mayor Job Description as presented in the draft dated June 24, 2025.
