I am writing yet again to express my total opposition to the Cashman plan for Mount Decatur. I have written before, both to you and to The Day. I have spoken at one of the endless P&Z Commission meetings. Yet I find myself compelled to attempt, once again, to say how dangerous this plan is for the Gales Ferry community and for Ledyard as a whole.

The people who live close to this proposed dredging—and, make no mistake, it IS dredging—face damage to their foundations, to their wells, and to their health. The children whose schools and day care centers are located nearby, especially any who already suffer from asthma and other health issues, will be negatively impacted.
